- **Transfer Process**

Limestone University has ended its role as an SC Institution of Higher Education. This closure triggers closure of Limestone Charter Association (LCA) per state law. This is not a reflection of LCA performance or leadership.

This is our transition year. We are currently serving as the authorizer until June 30, 2026, we are working collaboratively with the State Department, Angel meets with them on a bi-weekly basis.

No new schools approved, or transfers accepted into LCA.

All LCA-sponsored schools must transfer to new authorizers by July 1, 2026.

Comments from Bridgett Fowler



We will still be their authorizer, they will not move to their new authorizers until July 1, 2026. We appreciate that our schools have been so graciously accepted by other authorizers, but we will still lead the charge with Angel and her amazing team. Again, LCA is not being closed for misuse of funds, any violations in FOIA, it is because our higher ed, very unexpectedly shut down. We will continue to work as an Authorizer, making sure that schools have that autonomy to run their school and make all those changes that's in the best interest of the students of South Carolina. It's about the students, we are thankful that we have other Authorizers that have accepted our schools, we hope that we have a good positive transition and keep moving forward.
